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### JOB DESCRIPTION: LUXEMBOURG MEN'S HEAD COACH VOLLEYBALL

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#### ROLE PURPOSE

The primary duties of this position consist of instructing athletes in the skill development for their sport, as well as physical health, teamwork, safety and other instructional areas related to volleyball development.

This position is designated as a temporary (01.09.2019 – 30.06.2021), part-time (20h/week).

#### KEY RESPONSIBILITIES

Upholding the policies and values of the Luxembourg Volleyball Federation defined by its Board of Administration and demonstrate these in all communications and activities.

Designing a programme of training incorporating technical, tactical, physical, mental skills and wellbeing leading to Volleyball Development → LTAD.

Implementing and monitoring individual development plans for all players.

Overseeing the implementation of an athlete education programme incorporating strength and conditioning, anti-doping, nutrition and mental skills.

Upholding a fair selection policy to appoint players to take part at squad trainings and competitions. Supplying timely feedback on all selections and deselections.

Supporting the development of a pool of assistant coaches and inspiring them to teach youngsters and instruct them at appropriate competitions.





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Working closely with club trainers, identifying talented players by observing matches and trainings. Fixing specific terms and conditions for choosing candidates to be included in the team and assessing their playing abilities on a daily basis.

Working closely with the technical director to plan, monitor and evaluate the programme ensuring that the budget for the programme is efficiently managed.

Reporting at least twice per year and anytime on request to the Board of Administration on following items:

- Programme development
- Athletes' progress
- The physical and mental wellbeing of athletes
- Selection and deselection considerations
- Performance at competitions

Previous coaching experience.

Excellent leadership, team-building and motivational skills, including determination, patience and enthusiasm.
